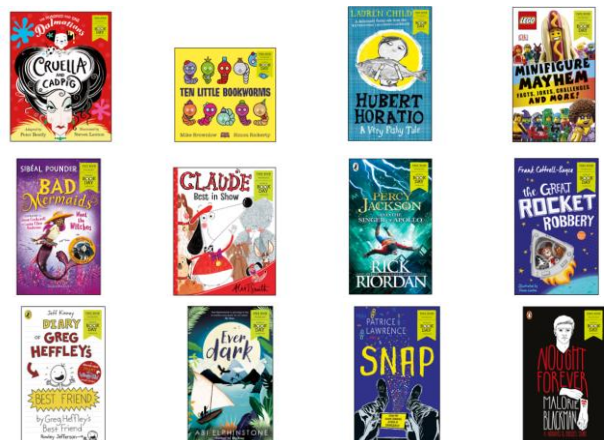
Parents of children in Early Years, Year 1 and Year 2 are also invited into school to join your child with their reading at 2:30pm on Thursday 7th March.
