At the end of the summer term, Year 3 worked alongside DP World and Blue marine to design marine conservation artwork to decorate a storage container in the docks. Blue marine is a conservation charity who are currently working on securing the oyster population in the Solent. They have a storage container in the docks and asked the children to design artwork to decorate it.

The designs have been made into shrink wrap which is now wrapped around the container.
