* To read every day with your child for at least 15 min., talk about the book, ask questions and make a record in their reading logs.

* Please remember to check your child's book bag and take out all the things that we send home.

* P.E. DAY — Both classes have PE on Tuesday morning make sure your child has their PE kit.

Home Challenge:

- Keep practising with your child daily their letter sounds and key words. Can they write them? Can they write a sentence using their key words?
- Play a Keyword treasure hunt with your child! Ask your child to write the words on sticky notes and then hide them around your home. Give your child 5 min to find the words. They can only 'win' the word if they can say it.
- Talk to your child about the things you have been doing during your day, ask your child to talk about their day. Draw pictures together, write words/sentences, and make a little diary...
- You can draw, write or take a photo of your home challenge and bring it to school so we can all share!
