




Year R Learning Journey

Week beginning 24th June



This week our topic will be 'Space'!



We will be reading the story 'Whatever Next' by Jill Murphy and thinking about what it would be like to go to space. We will be using junk modelling to make rockets and writing instructions on how to get ready to go to space.

In maths we will be recapping 2D and 3D shapes; recognising them, talking about their properties and finding them in our local environment.

In phonics we will be recapping all letter sounds and focusing on application.
