Dear Parent/Carers,

In order to bring alive this term's Stone Age topic, we have managed to arrange a visit to Stonehenge for children in year 3. The children will leave school at 9am and will return by approximately 2:45pm on **Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> November 2023**.

Children should wear their school uniform as normal. This should include sturdy, comfortable shoes and they should bring with them a packed lunch. Please ensure that they have a non-fizzy drink, no glass bottles or cans and no sweets. Packed lunch will be provided for children entitled to free school meals, but they can bring their own if they prefer.

As part of the trip, the children will get the opportunity to visit and walk around the stones as well as explore the visitor centre which has an excellent exhibition on the history of the site and how Stonehenge came into being. In previous years, English Heritage have also had experts on hand who gave demonstrations on stone age tools and clothing. It promises to be a thoroughly rewarding and educational visit for the children.

We would welcome a contribution of £12.50 to cover the cost of the visit; please pay this through the Parents Arbor app. It may be that some parents are not in a financial position to be able to pay all or part of the voluntary contribution, however any amount would be appreciated as without these payments the trip might not be able to go ahead.

The children are not allowed to bring pocket money as we will not be visiting the shop. The children should not bring personal equipment such as mobile phones and cameras on this trip.
