### **Year 2 Trip update**

In Summer 1, Year 2 will study The Titanic as part of their history unit. With this in mind, we would like to take the children to the Sea City Museum in Southampton. This trip will be a wonderful and valuable experience for them, helping to consolidate their learning. Whilst taking part in this day, children will be able to take part in some amazing activities including:

- **Titanic Workshop**  
Children will explore life on board through dressing up, artefact-handling and cross-curricular hands-on activities.
- **Titanic Discovery Session**  
Children will follow the stories of the crew who lived and worked on board RMS Titanic in an engaging and sensitive way.
- **Exploring the museum**  
Children will also have time to explore the museum with their classes.

As a team, we have been working on this trip since November however, it has been proving very expensive due to rising transport costs. Despite having spoken to many companies, the lowest cost we could find was £19.57 per child.

However, after many emails back and forth, we have had an amazing offer from one of our Partnership schools offering us use of their minibuses! While this will require some shuttling back and forth to Sea City Museum, it reduces the cost of the trip to £9.50 per child which is fantastic!

Currently, we are finalising dates and details, but we wanted to share as much as we could with you as soon as possible. Going forward, we will send out more information; in the meantime, see the below breakdown for this trip.

#### **Initial cost per child.**

 Transport per child: £12.50  
 Total cost per child: £19.57
