- Practise name writing with your child (capital letter for first letter only).

- Please read to your child as much as possible. Talk about the pictures before you read the words. What can you see? What do they think might happen next?
- Play games with sounds! Can your child tell you the first sound they can hear in words? For example, 's' for socks.
