We are very excited because this week in phonics the children will start learning their letter sounds! Please remember to ask them every day what sound did they learn at school?

This week our topic will be: The Colour Monster

We will be exploring different feelings and emotions with the children.

Together, we'll talk about how we can recognise when we are feeling happy, sad, angry, scared, or calm, and think about ways we can help ourselves and others when these feelings arise.

In maths we will be working on sorting and matching. The children will be having a go at spotting matching pairs,

How you can help at home:

- Practise name writing with your child (capital letter for first letter only).
- Help your child to recognise their own name at home.
- Practise dressing and undressing independently.
- Please read to your child as much as possible. Talk about the front cover first; what do the children think the story might be about? Then talk about the pictures before you read the words. What can you see? What do they think might happen next?
- Practise the sounds your child has learnt in school. Can they write them? Can they think of any words starting with that sound?

Please remember:

* Please remember to label everything, particularly school sweatshirts, t-shirts, coats and PE kits.
