This week our topic:
Marvellous Me!



The children will continue learning all about themselves and their families.

In Literacy, we will be exploring the story *Owl Babies*. The children will sequence the story and enjoy acting it out together.

In Maths, our focus will be on comparing sizes, lengths, and amounts. We will also be singing number songs and traditional nursery rhymes such as *Once I Caught a Fish* and *Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star*.

We will be learning about friendships—thinking about what makes a good friend, how we can be kind to each other, and ways to make new friends.
