Next week our topic will be Autumn



We will be learning about the **seasons** and going on nature walks to explore the woods. To find out more about autumn, the children will enjoy reading non-fiction books and taking part in lots of creative activities using natural objects such as acorns, colourful leaves, and twigs. They will also have the chance to make their own autumn collages.

In Maths, we will begin learning about the numbers 1, 2, and 3. The children will practise recognising these numbers, counting objects, exploring different representations, and starting to write them.

How you can help at home:

- Practise name writing with your child (capital letter for first letter only) and help them to recognise their own name.
 - Practise dressing and undressing independently.
 - Count things around the house such as shoes, socks, spoons, toys, etc.
 - Read books and practise the sounds your child has learnt. Can they find in books any letters we learnt at school?
 - Talk about the front cover first; what do the children think the story might be about? Then talk about the pictures before you read the words.
 - It has been so lovely to see so many of you share the home reading book. Please write in your child's reading diary when you have read with them.
