## The Proposed Development

The existing school buildings are nearing the end of their building life and so have been successful in securing funding for their replacement via the DfE-funded, School Rebuild Programme (SRP). Following extensive assessments of the existing buildings, replacement is deemed the most cost-effective solution for providing suitable education buildings for the future of this school.

Following careful consideration, it is proposed to replace the buildings with an attractive, modern, purpose-designed and fully accessible school building. The new buildings will incorporate the latest net-zero carbon neutral energy systems with on-site parking and school drop-off arrangements retained and improved. All playing fields are retained and the school playgrounds facilities will be enhanced, providing a more pleasant environment within which to learn.

A refreshed landscape, demonstrated above, with new planting and tree management will also bring about many environmental and biodiversity enhancements.
