Week beginning 20th October



This week we are going to consolidate everything that we have been learning so far!



In Literacy, the children will use their letter sounds to build simple words. They will have fun reading and writing words like *cat*, *mat*, *dog*, and *log*, and exploring how sounds come together to make words.

In Maths, we will be revisiting numbers and exploring **2D shapes**. The children will sort shapes, hunt for them in the environment, and use them creatively to make pictures and patterns.

Please remember:

* Please remember to check your child's book bag and take out all the lovely pictures, work, and things that we send home.

* P.E. DAY — Both classes have PE on Friday morning make sure your child has their PE kit.

* Please remember to try to read at least 3 times a week with your child, and to fill in their reading record so we know how they are getting on.

* As the weather is getting colder and colder, please remember, that it is important to bring a coat to school every day as we are learning outside whatever the weather.
