



# Year R Learning Journey

Week beginning 3<sup>rd</sup> November

This week our topic will be rhyming words!



**Literacy:** This week, the children will be exploring rhyming words and rhymes. We will be singing nursery rhymes, playing rhyming word bingo, finding rhyming pairs, and having fun with words—including having a go at writing some simple ones.

**Maths:** In Maths, we will be revisiting numbers 1, 2, and 3, as well as patterns. The children will practise counting and matching quantities, work on number formation, and use their skills through a range of hands-on activities.

\* **If your child is not yet able to tie their shoelaces**, we ask that they wear **velcro shoes** to school.
