



Year R Learning Journey

Week beginning 10th November

This week our topic will be **Goldilocks and the Three Bears**



We will be learning our new story — *Goldilocks and the Three Bears*! The children will have lots of fun tasting porridge, making their own puppets, and acting out the story together.

In maths, we will be focusing on the numbers **4** and **5** — learning how to write them, count and subitise, and explore different ways to make these numbers through play and practical activities. We'll also be discovering primary and secondary colours, experimenting with colour mixing, and creating some beautiful artwork along the way.

Please remember:

*To ensure that your child's red book bag is in school every day with their reading book and reading log.

*Please remember to try to read at least 3 times a week with your child, and to fill in their reading record so we know how they are getting on.

*As the weather is getting colder and colder, please remember, that it is important to bring a coat to school every day as we are learning outside whatever the weather.

* Please remember to label everything, particularly school sweatshirts, t-shirts, coats, and PE kits.

Home challenge:

- Make simple puppets from paper, socks, or craft materials, and use them to retell the story or invent new adventures.
- Keep practising with your child daily their letter sounds. Can they write them as you dictate? Can they sound it out and blend letters together?
- Play this game and practise blending [Pick A Picture \(phonicsplay.co.uk\)](#)
- Practice numbers by focusing on the numbers **4** and **5**. Count objects around the house, practise writing the numbers, or create small collections of 4 and 5 items (e.g., toys, fruit, or blocks).
- Keep encouraging your child to practise writing their name, this could be 5 minutes a day. Make sure they have a capital letter at the start and the rest of their name is in lower case.
- We would like you to write a letter from Goldilocks to say sorry for breaking into bear's cottage, for eating the porridge, breaking the chair, and sleeping in baby bear's bed. Have fun!
