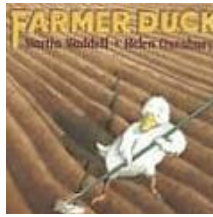


Year R Learning Journey

In maths, we will be focusing numbers 1 - 5. We will be learning how to write them, count and subitise, make them in different ways and put in the right order.
