### Year 2 trip

We are excited to inform you that the whole of Year 2 will be going on a trip to visit the Southampton Art Gallery on Thursday, 21st May 2025. This trip will enhance the children's understanding of the Art curriculum and inspire their own artistic expression. It will also provide an opportunity for them to explore a wide range of artworks and engage with creative processes.

In addition to viewing the art, the children will participate in two workshops: '*Differences and Similarities Discovery*' and '*Titanic Printing*'. These workshops are closely linked to the work they have been doing this year. As a bonus, we will also visit the *Southampton Stories* exhibition at the Sea City Museum next door, which links with their history learning about the Titanic.

We will be leaving school just after 9:00 am and will return by the end of the school day. Children should wear their school uniform and bring appropriate clothing for the weather, such as a coat if rain is forecast.

On the day, Year 2 children will be provided with a packed lunch. **Please provide them with a backpack** to carry this in and indicate their choice of filling on the attached consent form. If they would prefer to bring their own lunch, they may do so in their backpack, but please ensure that it does not include fizzy drinks, glass bottles, or cans.

**To make this trip happen, we are asking for a contribution of £13.87 per child.** While we appreciate this may seem expensive, we are thrilled to add this to the children's learning experience. The breakdown of these costs is as follows:

- £6.26 per child for the workshops
- £7.61 per child for the coach

Although we are really looking forward to this trip and feel it would be a great addition to the children's learning, we will have to cancel it if enough money is not received by Monday 18<sup>th</sup> May. Payments need to be made via the Arbor parent app. You can also pay in instalments via the App, with all instalments due by Monday 18<sup>th</sup> May 2026.
