SATS WEEK ARRANGEMENTS

Dear Parents,

SATs week (w/b Monday 11th May) is nearly here! Year 6 have been working extremely hard to prepare for the challenges that lie ahead. We would like to take this opportunity to remind you of the importance of your child attending school **on time** and **every day** during the week. In the event of illness, please contact the school by 8.15am **at the latest** so we can give advice on the most appropriate course of action.

Breakfast Club

In order to settle the children in to the school day as quickly and smoothly as possible during SATs week, we will be running an early morning breakfast club. In previous years, children have thoroughly enjoyed the opportunity to eat together and socialise before the tests start. The club will be open between 8 and 8.35am on Monday 11th, Tuesday 12th, Wednesday 13th and Thursday 14th. Children need to enter via the school office entrance no earlier than 8am. Children will be able to go directly to their classrooms on these days once they have finished eating their breakfast.

A variety of food options will be available to the children each day. These will include: a variety of cereals; toast with a selection of spreads; fresh fruit; cold meats and cheeses; fruit juice; tea and hot chocolate. We will also provide a daily 'special' which varies through the week. If you would like your child to take advantage of this facility, there will be a charge of **£1.50 per day or £5 for all 4 days**. This needs to be paid **through Arbor** (our online payment system) in advance, by **Tuesday 5th May**. Please ensure you pay into '**Year 6 SATs Breakfast Club**', **not** the standard before-school breakfast club held at The Brook. This can be found under the heading 'Trips'.

SATs Week Fun Day

There will be no tests on Friday 15th May. Consequently, we will be holding a Year 6 'Fun Day' in recognition of the children's hard work in the build-up to SATs week. The children will have a variety of fun, outdoor activities on offer so will need to ensure they have their PE kits in school.

On our fun afternoon, we have secured a booking with an ice cream van. If you would like your child to receive an ice cream/lolly/slush at the special subsidised rate of £2, please send in the exact money on the day with your child. There will be an opportunity for parents and siblings to treat themselves at the end of the school day too (however these will be charged at standard prices).
