We have been lucky enough, here at Tanners Brook, to take part in WOW, the walk to school challenge. It is a pupil-led initiative where children self-report how they get to school every day using an interactive WOW Travel Tracker in classrooms. If they travel sustainably (walk/wheel, cycle or scoot) at least once a week for a month, they get rewarded with a badge. The project is delivered by Living Streets in partnership with Southampton City Council.

We have only just launched the initiative in school and will receive a visit from Strider, the WOW challenge mascot, next **Monday 8<sup>th</sup> June**. Strider will be arriving at Tanners Brook at **8.15am** and will be around for the duration of school drop off.

As your child is an Eco-Warrior and will be supporting their class to complete the WOW challenge, we would love for them to stand with Strider during the school drop off. Living Streets would love to capture the visit at Tanners Brook and share images or short videos with Active Travel England and partners about the impact that WOW is having.
