

KS2 Sports Day 2026

Dear Parents and Carers

This year's KS2 Sports Day will be held on Friday 26th June and you are invited to come and support your child/children. Please begin to arrive at 8:50am and go straight to the field. From 9:10am there will be a range of fun events based upon the skills your child has been practising in their physical education lessons. Throughout the morning until 10:45am, the children stay in their house teams competing for their house and winning points. There will be 8 events, and each team will be given approximately 5 minutes on each station to score as many points as they can. The house with the most points at the end of the morning will win the school shield.

You are invited to follow your child/children around the course. Where possible, children with siblings have been placed in the same team so you will only need to follow one team. Limited seating is provided – you may bring fold up chairs if you wish. General encouragement for your child and their team is appreciated but please reserve personal congratulations to the end of the morning!

Please ensure that your child wears their PE kit into school on the day, including shorts, white T-shirt and trainers. As the children will be competing for their house, the children will wear a coloured band to identify their house. Children who wear earrings (including studs) and watches will need to leave these at home for the day. If your child has long hair, this will need to be put up.

Please make sure you provide your children with water bottles for the day. It is looking like it will be a hot day, so a hat and sun cream would also provide your child with extra protection. If the weather is bad and we need to postpone Sports Day, a text message will be sent out to parents. We will do this as early as possible.

Parents of children who will be competing in the running race finals (heats are being carried out as part of the children's normal PE lessons) from 11am will also be able to attend this event; you will be notified as soon as possible if this applies to your child.

We look forward to seeing you all there on the day.
