This week our topic is Pirates Adventures!



On **Monday 15th June**, children are invited to come to school dressed as pirates. As one of our **7 for 7** special experiences, we will be having a **Pirate Day**! We are so looking forward to a day full of pirate-themed activities, stories, and adventures. This week we will be making treasure maps, singing pirate songs, reading pirate stories and later we will create our own story maps and use all the skills that we have learnt to write our own pirate adventure story. In maths we will be counting, recapping numbers, consolidating addition and subtraction, and using our skills to solve problems.

Please remember:

- * **P.E. day** — Both classes will have PE on **Thursday** afternoon this half term. Please ensure your child has a named **PE kit and trainers** in school so they can take part in all activities.
- * Read every day with your child for at least 15 min. talk about the book and make a record in their reading logs. Reading at home regularly does make a difference!
- * Please make sure your child comes into school with their own named water bottle. They will be able to refill it throughout the day.
- * We kindly ask that if your child brings a packed lunch to school, please ensure it contains healthy and nutritious food to support their energy and learning throughout the day. Thank you very much for your support in promoting healthy eating habits.
