How you can help at home:

- Practise name writing with your child (capital letter for first letter only).
- Help your child to recognise their own name at home.
- Practise dressing and undressing independently.
- > Count things around the house such as shoes, socks, spoons, toys, etc.
- Please read to your child as much as possible. Talk about the front cover first; what do the children think the story might be about? Then talk about the pictures before you read the words. What can you see? What do they think might happen next?
- Practise the sounds your child has learnt in school. Can they think of any words starting with that sound?
- Play games with sounds! Can your child tell you the first sound they can hear in words? For example 's' for socks.
