Dear parents/carers,

As I am sure you are aware, we are awaiting an announcement from the government regarding the reopening of schools to all pupils. We know that this will not be before the 8th March but do not know what will happen after this date.

Therefore, in readiness for a possible reopening, we have made the decision to ask those children in our key worker groups to come to school in full uniform after half term (from 22nd February) on the days they do not have PE.

Therefore, Tanners Brook uniform should be worn as follows:

Early Years: Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday (PE kit on Tuesday)

Year 1: Monday and Friday (PE kit on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday)

Year 2: Monday, Wednesday and Friday (PE kit on Tuesday and Thursday)

Year 3: Monday, Thursday and Friday (PE kit on Tuesday and Wednesday)

Year 4: Monday, Tuesday and Thursday (PE kit on Wednesday and Friday)

Year 5: Monday, Thursday and Friday (PE kit on Tuesday and Wednesday)

Year 6: Monday, Wednesday and Thursday (PE kit on Tuesday and Friday)

Please note, on the days the children come to school in PE kit, this should be as per our uniform expectations:

- PE shorts/skirt or black jogging bottoms/leggings in the cold weather
- P.E. T-Shirt – white (with or without school logo)
- Black/dark plain sweatshirt or hoodie for the cold weather
- No logos or patterns
- Trainers or plimsols
