



# Year R Learning Journey

Week beginning 29<sup>th</sup> March



**This week our topic will be 'Easter'**



We will be learning about the Easter story. We will be talking about different traditions and how people celebrate Easter. Children will be carrying out lots of different Easter and spring activities, including singing songs, crafty activities, making chocolate nests, making and writing cards. In maths we will be learning about weight. We will investigate the weights of different objects, which is heavier and which is lighter. We will be ordering objects according to their weights and use balancing scales to help us.

## **Please remember:**

- \* Read every day with your child for at least 15 min. talk about the book and make a record in their reading logs.
- \* Every day your child needs to bring a named water bottle.

## **Key words that we learnt so far:**

**I, the, go, no, to, in, into, put, and, he, she, we, be, me, is, was, they, a, at, are, you, my, all, said, have, are, little, like, went.**

**In phonics we will be recapping all letter sounds and focusing on application.**

## **Home Challenges:**

- When you are out and about in the park or in the playground - look out for a seesaw! Try it with your mummy or daddy or sister... Which side of the seesaw goes up? Which side goes down? Why? Who is heavier? Who is lighter?
- At home investigate the weights of different objects. Choose 3 objects. Which one is the heaviest? Which one is the lightest? Can you order them? Can you draw your objects and add labels?
- When you are out and about in the park, forest or in the playground - look out for spring signs - can you spot some bees buzzing or birds building their nests and tweeting happy songs? Can you find some spring flowers? What can you see, hear or smell?
- Play a game of pairs or snap using your keyword rainbow flashcards that we send home. Can you write your keywords? Can you think of a sentence with a keyword and write it down?
